



FLOWERS FOR SHARING



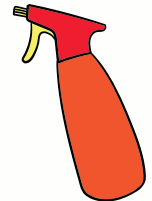
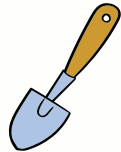

You will need:

- * A biodegradable pot, such as an empty paper egg carton
- * Soil
- * Flower seeds
- * A mini shovel or something to scoop soil with
- * A spray bottle filled with water



Steps:

Fill the pot almost to the top with soil

Place 2-3 seeds on top of the soil

Add a thin layer of soil on top of the seeds

Press the soil lightly, tucking them in like a blanket

Gently mist the soil with the spray bottle, like the rain would wet the ground

Put the pot on a windowsill so the seeds will have lots of sun

Wait for your flowers to sprout!
